### French River Painting Trip (July 13-19 six nights)

This trip down one of Canada's most historic rivers showcases the unforgettable vistas of Georgian Bay. Rocky islands and shorelines, wind blown white pines, and dramatic sunsets, all combine to make this one of Ontario's most distinctive canoeing destinations. Watercolourist Martha Bull will be on hand to help painters of all skill levels capture the colour and diversity of the landscape, which has drawn so many artists over the years.

### Killarney (July 27-August 2, six nights)

### Chiniguichi (August 10-15, five nights)
