Chiniguichi to Sturgeon River (June 25-July 3, eight nights)

Starting in the beautiful Chiniguichi Waterway Park, this trip through the wilds of southeastern Temagami combines big lakes and river travel on the lower Sturgeon. Featuring great swimming and hiking, old growth red pine forest, and isolated backcountry for those with some experience of white water and an appreciation for portaging.

Temagami: Diamond Lake Loop (July 17-23, six nights)

A fine introduction to the beauty and history of Temagami for the moderately experienced or enthusiastic novice canoeist, this trip features daily paddling and portaging, with time to swim, hike in the old growth red and white pine forest. Big, sparkling lakes in the heart of Temagami with open campsites and spectacular scenery, good fishing and great swimming.

Killarney North (July 31-August 7, seven nights)

The creation of Killarney Lakelands and Headwaters Provincial Park offers new opportunities to explore the more isolated northwest section of the park. Starting on majestic Panache Lake, this trip features the distinctive beauty and ruggedness of the La Cloche Mountains, great opportunities for hiking, swimming and photography, including two nights on spectacular Nellie Lake.
